WHAT IS OUR EXTRA CURRICULAR PROVISION?

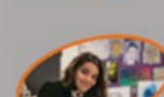
We offer a range of breaktime and lunchtime clubs every day, from basketball and table tennis to movie and chess club. We also host regular charity and Gateway events, providing plenty of opportunities for students to get involved beyond the classroom.

What to do at Lunch time?

“Break and lunch are 30 minutes long, with plenty of ways to spend your time. Most students choose between the Courtyard Café, the courtyard, or the astro/hardcourt.
