RE: TRIP TO NHS AND SOCIAL CARE EXPLORATION DAY– WEDNESDAY 11 FEBRUARY 2026

I am delighted to inform you that your child has been chosen to go on a Careers Event to Anglia Ruskin University, Chelmsford Campus on **Wednesday 11 February 2026**. The Health Sector STEAM Careers Event is designed to demonstrate the rich variety of roles in health-based STEAM careers. The event will include interactive career stations, activities and workshops to help young people visually bridge the gap between what they enjoy doing and what they could potentially do as a future career.

We will be travelling by coach to Chelmsford, departing the Academy at 8:45 am and returning around 3:30 pm (traffic permitting), at which time students will be dismissed. The cost of the trip is £8.50 to cover transport, payable via ParentPay. The event itself is free. Students should bring a packed lunch and a water bottle; those entitled to free school meals will have a lunch provided from the canteen before departure. School uniform **must** be worn and students should remember that they will be representing the Academy throughout the day.
