### **EASTER HOLIDAY SCHOOL – YEARS 10 AND 11 MONDAY 30 MARCH – THURSDAY 02 APRIL**

We are pleased to invite your child to attend our **Easter Holiday School**, following another year in which the Academy's performance exceeded the national average by a significant margin. This programme is designed to maximise learning through ambitious and challenging activities that support both academic progress and student wellbeing. Evidence shows that students who attend holiday school typically demonstrate improved progress in subsequent assessments.

The Easter Holiday School will provide focused teaching in English, Maths and Science. In addition, students who attend all three days will be offered the opportunity to take part in a **free reward trip** to Hollywood Bowl, Lakeside, on Thursday 02 April 2026, which includes one hour of bowling and food.

The Easter Holiday School will run from Monday 30 March to Thursday 02 April, 9:00 am to 1:30 pm each day and an example of the structure is listed below. Students should enter and exit via the **main Academy entrance**, signing in and out daily. All students will receive a free stationery pack and lunch will be provided at no cost each day. School uniform is not required; however, students should wear comfortable and appropriate clothing. Please note that places are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis with priority going to students with high levels of attendance, merits and demonstration of the school values.
