**THE HUNGER GAMES ON STAGE THEATRE TRIP – TROUBADOUR CANARY WHARF THEATRE  
 WEDNESDAY 10 JUNE 2026**

We greatly value the dedication and effort demonstrated by the students here at The Gateway Academy. As a gesture of our appreciation, we have organised a special trip to reward this outstanding group of students with the support of Go Live Theatre Projects. I am thrilled to inform you that we have secured tickets for The Hunger Games on Stage at the Troubadour Canary Wharf Theatre, on Wednesday 10 June 2026.

Students will travel by coach to and from the Troubadour Canary Wharf Theatre. They should arrive at school at their normal time and attend Periods 1 to 4 as usual. At 1.00 pm, students must meet in the Courtyard Café, ready for departure at 1.15 pm. Students should bring sufficient food and drink for the day, including a packed lunch. Lunch will be provided for students eligible for free school meals. We expect to return to The Gateway Academy at approximately 6.00 pm, traffic permitting. Students will be dismissed on arrival and parents / carers **must** arrange collection from the Academy. Students are required to wear full school uniform and are reminded that they are representing the Academy throughout the trip. Please note that the company who are funding the trip may take photos/videos and share them on their website/social media during the event.

The show is approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes long and is a theatrical adaptation, of the hit book brought to life. Step into the world of Panem and follow Katniss Everdeen - the Girl on Fire - as her story of courage, hope and defiance ignites before your eyes. **Content Guidance:** This production contains loud noises and explosions, haze and smoke, flashing and strobe lighting. There are depictions of murder and manslaughter and references to themes of death, grief and guilt.

Tickets are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. The total cost of the trip is £25.00, which includes your child's coach travel and ticket to the performance, (please note that these tickets would normally cost over £80.00 each!). Payment should be made via ParentPay. Your child's participation will only be confirmed when the following google form has been completed and payment has been made: <https://forms.gle/nopeg75wAvVHxE497>.

A Google account is not required, although the link may need to be opened in Google Chrome. Kindly ensure the Google Form is completed and submitted by **Wednesday 03 June 2026**. Students without a completed consent form will not be able to participate in this theatre visit and should attend lessons as normal.
