**WALK ONLINE ROADSHOW – ONLINE SAFETY, CIVIC HALL, BLACKSHOTS – WEDNESDAY 22 MARCH 2023**

The Gateway Academy has arranged for all Year 8 students to attend the Walk Online Roadshow at the Civic Hall on Wednesday 22 March 2023. We will be travelling to and from the venue by coach. Students are expected to be in school at their usual time of 08.10 am and go to Periods 1, 2 3 and 4.

This workshop will look at the online world and how our young people are using it. It will explore how they are navigating around restrictions and using the internet without their parent's knowledge. It will include content in regards to favourite apps and games and will look at the dangers young people face not only from predatory bad people but also how they are being groomed in games, which ranges from receiving gifts for the younger player (Primary age) and being groomed on servers for the older players (Year 5 and secondary).

The workshop will also look at bullying across all age ranges and explore the use that gangs make of the online world. It will also look at sexting and how all young people are being influenced online and forming ideologies and views that might oppose their parents/carers, which can also give them a skewed view of the world. It also looks at how influencers work, which can lead our children to conduct dangerous challenges.

We will be leaving the Academy promptly at 12.15 pm and should be back onsite by 14.45 am (traffic permitting) when students will be dismissed. Students will be expected to wear school uniform and should remember that they will be representing The Academy throughout this trip. Those attending the trip will need to bring a packed lunch and drink for their lunch on this day. Students entitled to free school meals will have a packed lunch provided for them.
