YEAR 7

Year 7 have continued this term as they left of from Easter—very positively indeed. Attendance has seen a sustained increase and continues to better the national average by some distance. Students are really maintaining their resilience and ensuring they are here to meet every day head on. Our top three tutor groups are:

1st - 7G with 97.17%

2nd - 7F with 95.82%

3rd - 7B with 95.70%

It was an extremely close contest but it will be 7G, 7F and 7B who receive their reward on Friday for their exceptional resilience. Well done.

Year 7 are now kings of Gateway for achievement points with a combined total of 13,667 R4U points and hundreds of points ahead of the next closest year group. The compassion they show for each other every single day, the aspiration in their learning and desire to improve upon their best and the responsibility they demonstrate in and around the Academy is a real tribute to the people they are growing into. We have three outstanding tutor groups who have built the highest R4U totals, they are:

1st - 7C with 2,122

2nd - 7F with 2,041

3rd - 7E with 2,022

A very close contest but one which demonstrates the desire Year 7 has to succeed. Rewards will be distributed on Friday. Congratulations!

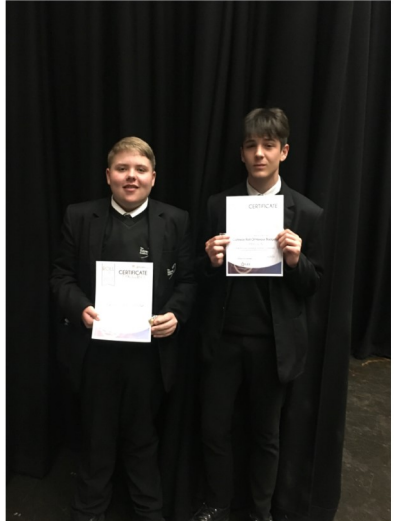
