**RE: KS4 HISTORY TRIP – IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM LONDON – 16 NOVEMBER 2023**

I am writing to inquire if your child would be interested in joining The Gateway Academy's excursion to the Imperial War Museum in London. We have scheduled a one-day visit for 60 students on Thursday 16 November 2023. This outing will provide students with the opportunity to explore the medical aspects of the Western Front during World War I. It will focus on significant medical treatments, ground-breaking discoveries, and the impact of WW1 battles on the soldiers. This experience will serve as valuable preparation for their studies in the final section of the GCSE curriculum, "Medicine on the Western Front." The trip is open to Year 11 students and promises to be an engaging and educational adventure.

The Academy has generously covered most of the trip's expenses, however, a contribution of £15.00 per student is required. This contribution covers the following:

- School transportation to and from the museum.
- Admission fees.
- Study materials and information packs.
- Museum entry.
- Student insurance.

Students should arrive at the Academy by 8:00 am and proceed to the Elis Theatre for registration. We will depart promptly at 8:15 am and travel to the museum by coach. Our aim is to return to the Academy by approximately 3:15 pm, (traffic permitting). Upon arrival, students will be dismissed. Please make alternative arrangements for your child's journey home from school on this day.

To secure a spot for your child, we kindly request that you complete and return the consent form below to **Student Services** by Monday 02 October 2023, confirming your payment of £15.00 via ParentPay. Please be aware that available places are limited to a maximum of 60 and they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. This will, however, be dependent upon students' attendance, behaviour, and academic records when making selections. Regrettably, students who do not meet the trip requirements will not be able to participate.

I hope that you will agree that this is a fantastic opportunity for your child and look forward to receiving your signed consent forms and non-refundable contribution by **Monday 02 October 2023**.
