When a baby escapes a murderer intent on killing the entire family, who would have thought it would find safety and security in the local graveyard?

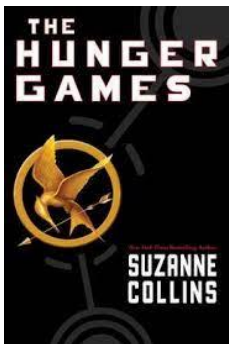

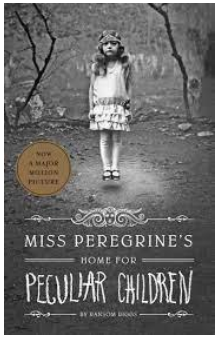
Summer 1945. The Second World War is finally over and Yossi, Ben and Mordecai are among three hundred children who have arrived in the English Lake District.

The country is holding its breath. Death has never been busier.

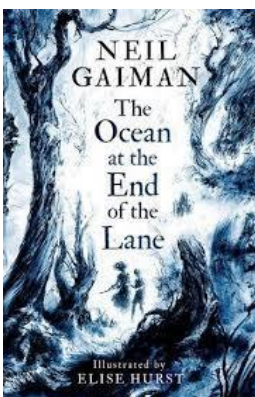

As the boys' delicate sense of order fades, so their childish dreams are transformed into something more primitive and their behaviour starts to take on a murderous, savage significance.

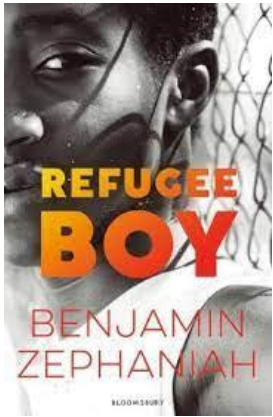


This is what he remembers, as he sits by the ocean at the end of the lane:

And dark forces woken that were best left undisturbed.

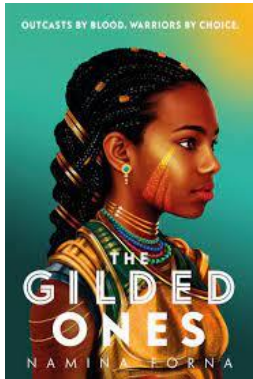
They are memories hard to believe, waiting at the edges of things.



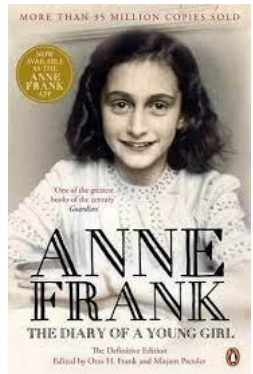


Life is not safe for Alem. His father is Ethiopian, his mother Eritrean. Their countries are at war, and Alem is welcome in neither place.
