We have been working tirelessly to ensure our students make progress. To continue to take advantage of this, we would like to maximise learning through the offer of a trip to Stubbers Activity Centre as a reward for your child's hard work and to support your child's wellbeing. Stubbers state, *"Step out of your comfort zone and into a world of adventure. Experience a range of extraordinary activities across land, air, water and motor. Students need to arrive at the Academy at 8.45 am and make their way to the Ellis Theatre to register. We will be leaving promptly at 9.00 am. Students will then be taken to and from the venue by coach. We are hoping to return to the Academy by 4.30 pm (traffic permitting) when students will be dismissed. Alternative arrangements will need to be made for your child's journey home from school.

Those attending the trip will be provided with a packed lunch but may want to bring additional food/water for the day. There is food available to purchase at the venue and students may wish to bring along extra money to purchase something, if they so wish. Contactless payment is preferred by the venue. Students will not be expected to wear school uniform, however; appropriate and comfortable clothing should be worn as students will be representing the Academy throughout the day. Students may also wish to bring along the following:

- Water Shoes (old trainers, you do not mind getting wet is fine).
- Closed Toe footwear for activities.
- Woolly hat (depend upon the weather).
- Refillable water bottle.

Students will take part in some of the following activities and may be offered more:

- Aerial Trekking, Climbing, Abseiling, Leap of Faith.
- Archery.
- Axe Throwing.
- Rifle Shooting.
