RE: IMMERSIVE GAMEBOX TRIP - FRIDAY 05 APRIL 2024

We have been working tirelessly to ensure our students make progress and our results last year were well above national average. To continue to take advantage of this, we would like to maximise learning through the offer of a **FREE** trip to <u>Immersive Gamebox</u>, Lakeside as a reward for your child's hard work during Easter Holiday School and to support your child's wellbeing.

Students can select to take part in one of the following age appropriate games:

Students need to arrive at Immersive Gamebox, Lakeside at 10:40 am and meet the lead teacher, Ms Mead, by the entrance of the venue. We will be entering the venue at 10:45 am, to ensure plenty of time to check in prior to their session beginning. The gaming sessions last an hour and then we will walk to McDonalds where we have a reserved section at 12:15 pm. We will be finished by 1.00 pm, when students will be dismissed.
