WHAT IS OUR EXTRA CURRICULAR PROVISION?

Every day, we offer a variety of lunchtime and breaktime clubs. We encourage all students to join an activity, like basketball, football, table tennis, movie club, or others. For example, the chess club boasts a vibrant community of students who not only enjoy playing chess but also engage in lively discussions encompassing mathematics and strategic moves within the world of chess. We regularly run various charity and Gateway events, giving students a wide range of experiences outside of the classroom.

What to do at Break and Lunch time?

“Break and Lunch is half an hour and there is a large variety of ways to spend your time. There are 3 main areas where most students spend their free time: the canteen, courtyard and the astro/hardcourt. In the canteen, you can buy and eat food, with plenty of tables available.
