RE: TRINITY LABAN DANCE TASTER DAY – TUESDAY 26 NOVEMBER 2024

I am delighted to inform you that your child has been selected to participate in dance taster day at Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance. Students will be taking part in a full day of workshops where they will be learning a range of dance styles as well as choreography and working on dance techniques. Students will also gain an insight into university life when studying a BA (Hons) degree in contemporary dance and dance science at Trinity Laban.

The workshops will take place at the Trinity Laban campus in London on Tuesday 26 November 2024. Students will travel to London by train (C2C) meeting to depart at Tilbury Train Station at 08.00 am, with the aim to return around 5.00 pm, when students will be dismissed. Alternative arrangements will need to be made for your child’s journey home from Tilbury Train Station. Students will need to wear their full PE kit; black Gateway PE top, black leggings and trainers, also bringing ballet shoes along with them to dance in. Those attending the trip will also need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water for the workshops. Students entitled to a free school meal will have a packed lunch and drink provided for them.
